

- (4) SELLING THE PRODUCT;
- (5) TRANSFERRING THE PRODUCT; OR
- (6) MOVING THE PRODUCT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Article 43, § 896 and the enumeration of activities in § 894(a).

The reference to an "injunction forbidding" one or more of the enumerated activities is derived from the reference to an "embargo" in former Article 43, § 896 and from the enumeration of activities in former Article 43, § 894(a).

6-206. PROHIBITED ACTS; EXCEPTIONS.

(A) SCOPE OF GUARANTY.

A GUARANTY UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE:

(1) A SEPARATE GUARANTY THAT SPECIFICALLY DESIGNATES THE PRODUCT, FABRIC, OR RELATED MATERIAL; OR

(2) A CONTINUING GUARANTY THAT:

(I) IS GIVEN BY A SELLER TO A BUYER;

(II) APPLIES TO ANY PRODUCT, FABRIC, OR RELATED MATERIAL SOLD TO THE BUYER; AND

(III) IS IN THE FORM THE DEPARTMENT APPROVES.

(B) MANUFACTURE OR SALE OF NONCONFORMING PRODUCTS.

A PERSON MAY NOT MANUFACTURE, SELL, OR HOLD WITH INTENT TO SELL ANY NEW OR UNUSED PRODUCT THAT DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THE FLAMMABILITY REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(C) PROVIDING FALSE GUARANTY.

A PERSON MAY NOT GIVE A FALSE GUARANTY.

(D) EXCEPTIONS.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO:

(1) RECEIVES IN GOOD FAITH A PRODUCT, FABRIC, OR RELATED MATERIAL THAT IS COVERED BY A GUARANTY THAT IS SIGNED BY AND CONTAINS THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE PERSON WHO MANUFACTURED THE PRODUCT, FABRIC, OR RELATED MATERIAL OR FROM WHOM IT WAS RECEIVED;
