6-422. PENALTIES.

(A) CIVIL PENALTY.

(1) A PERSON WHO WILLFULLY VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR ANY RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IS LIABLE FOR A CIVIL PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 TO BE COLLECTED IN A CIVIL ACTION.

(2) EACH DAY A VIOLATION CONTINUES IS A SEPARATE VIOLATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.

(B) CRIMINAL PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO PREVIOUSLY HAS BEEN ASSESSED A CIVIL PENALTY UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AND WHO WILLFULLY VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR ANY RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT:

(1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$20,000; OR

(2) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$25,000, OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 2 YEARS OR BOTH.
