

THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL'S DESIGNEE IN 1986; AND

(V) THE MEMBERS FROM THE INDUSTRY THAT GENERATES HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES, THE HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE DISPOSAL AND MANAGEMENT INDUSTRY, THE LOW-LEVEL NUCLEAR WASTE MANAGEMENT INDUSTRY, AND THE INDUSTRY THAT GENERATES LOW-LEVEL NUCLEAR WASTE AND 1 PUBLIC MEMBER IN 1987.

(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

The third sentence of former NR § 8-1413.2(e)(3), which related to members "as of June 30, 1980", is deleted as unnecessary.

7-213. OFFICERS.

FROM AMONG THE PUBLIC MEMBERS, THE COUNCIL ANNUALLY SHALL ELECT A CHAIRPERSON.

7-214. MEETINGS; COMPENSATION.

(A) MEETINGS.

THE COUNCIL SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS.

(B) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.

A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL:

(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
