THE COUNCIL SHALL ADVISE AND ASSIST THE DEPARTMENT IN:

(2) DEVELOPING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND DISPOSAL OF CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES; AND
