

AT LEAST ANNUALLY, THE SECRETARY SHALL:

(1) PUBLISH A REPORT OF VITAL STATISTICS, INCLUDING POPULATION ESTIMATES; AND

(2) PRINT AND DISTRIBUTE THE REPORT TO ANY OFFICIAL, AGENCY, LIBRARY, OR OTHER PERSON WHOM THE SECRETARY CONSIDERS ENTITLED TO THE REPORT.

4-220. VITAL STATISTICS.

(A) NATIONAL VITAL STATISTICS.

THE SECRETARY MAY PROVIDE THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES WITH COPIES OF VITAL RECORDS OR OTHER INFORMATION THAT IS REQUIRED FOR NATIONAL STATISTICS, ON THE CONDITION THAT THE INFORMATION MAY NOT BE USED FOR OTHER THAN STATISTICAL PURPOSES UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE SECRETARY.

(B) OTHER STATISTICAL PURPOSES.

ON REQUEST, THE SECRETARY MAY PROVIDE FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL, AND OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE AGENCIES WITH COPIES OF VITAL RECORDS OR OTHER INFORMATION FOR STATISTICAL PURPOSES ON TERMS OR CONDITIONS THAT THE SECRETARY SETS.
