THE SECRETARY MAY APPROVE SPECIFIC PROJECTS FOR TYPEWRITTEN, PHOTOGRAPHIC, OR OTHER REPRODUCTIONS OF ORIGINALS, CARBON COPIES, AND INDEXES OF VITAL RECORDS. THESE PROJECTS SHALL STATE THE METHOD OF REPRODUCTION, THE DISPOSITION OR LOCATION OF THE DEPOSITORY OF ANY RECORD REPRODUCED, AND THE TYPE OF RECORDS AND THE PERIOD COVERED.

4-222. HALL OF RECORDS.

(A) DEATH CERTIFICATES.

- (1) ON REQUEST OF THE HALL OF RECORDS COMMISSION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE THE COMMISSION, BY LOAN OR OTHERWISE, WITH PHOTOGRAPHIC COPIES OF DEATH CERTIFICATES.
- (2) AFTER APPROPRIATELY ORGANIZING AND INDEXING THE CERTIFICATES, THE HALL OF RECORDS COMMISSION MAY EXTRACT FROM THEM THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FOR USE BY RESEARCHERS AT THE HALL OF RECORDS:
 - (I) THE FULL NAME OF THE DECEASED.
- (II) THE PLACE OF RESIDENCE OF THE DECEASED.
- (III) THE DATE AND PLACE OF BIRTH OF THE DECEASED.
- (IV) THE DATE AND PLACE OF DEATH OF THE DECEASED.
- (V) THE FULL NAMES AND PLACES OF BIRTH OF THE PARENTS OF THE DECEASED.
- (VI) THE PLACE OF FINAL DISPOSITION OF THE DECEASED.
 - (VII) THE OCCUPATION OF THE DECEASED.
- (VIII) THE NAME AND RELATIONSHIP OF THE INFORMANT.
