4-225. ENFORCEMENT OF TITLE.

- (2) ON REQUEST OF THE SECRETARY, EACH REGISTRAR SHALL HELP THE SECRETARY IN THE INVESTIGATION.
 - (B) STATE'S ATTORNEY.

IF THE SECRETARY CONSIDERS IT NECESSARY, THE SECRETARY SHALL REPORT A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBTITLE TO THE STATE'S ATTORNEY FOR THE APPROPRIATE COUNTY, WITH A STATEMENT OF THE RELEVANT FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES, FOR APPROPRIATE ACTION.

A PERSON MAY NOT WILLFULLY PROVIDE FALSE INFORMATION FOR ENTRY OR WILLFULLY ENTER FALSE INFORMATION ON A CERTIFICATE OF BIRTH, DEATH, OR FETAL DEATH.
