

PART II. WATER SCIENCE ADVISORY BOARD.9-305. BOARD ESTABLISHED.THERE IS A WATER SCIENCE ADVISORY BOARD.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the reference in the first sentence of former Article 43, § 718 (a) to maintaining a Science Advisory Board.

It is set forth as a separate section for emphasis.

The word "Water" is added to the name of the Board for clarity and to conform to actual practice.

Former Article 43, § 718(h), which in effect provided that the Board was created as part of the comprehensive water pollution control program, is deleted as unnecessary.

9-306. MEMBERSHIP.(A) COMPOSITION; APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS.

(1) THE BOARD CONSISTS OF 9 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.

(2) OF THE BOARD MEMBERS:

(I) 1 SHALL BE APPOINTED FROM A LIST OF AT LEAST 3 QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND;

(II) 1 SHALL BE APPOINTED FROM A LIST OF AT LEAST 3 QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE JOHNS HOPKINS UNIVERSITY; AND

(III) 7 SHALL BE REPRESENTATIVES OF INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING, PRIVATE INDUSTRY, OR AGENCIES OF GOVERNMENT OR OTHER PUBLIC BODIES THAT NORMALLY ARE NOT ASSOCIATED WITH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACTIVITIES.

(B) QUALIFICATIONS.

EACH MEMBER SHALL BE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS SCIENTIFIC OR TECHNICAL EXPERTISE.

(C) TENURE; VACANCIES.

(1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 5 YEARS.
