

9-411. INJUNCTIVE ACTIONS.

IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER REMEDY AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE SECRETARY MAY BRING AN ACTION TO ENJOIN ANY VIOLATION OF ANY RULE, REGULATION, OR ORDER ADOPTED OR ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

9-412. PROHIBITED ACTS.(A) SUPPLIERS OF WATER.A SUPPLIER OF WATER MAY NOT:

(1) FAIL TO COMPLY WITH § 9-410 OF THIS SUBTITLE;

(2) DISSEMINATE ANY FALSE OR MISLEADING INFORMATION IN OR ABOUT ANY NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER § 9-410 OF THIS SUBTITLE OR ABOUT ANY REMEDIAL ACTION BEING UNDERTAKEN TO ACHIEVE COMPLIANCE WITH STATE PRIMARY DRINKING WATER REGULATIONS;

(3) FAIL TO COMPLY WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER § 9-407 OF THIS SUBTITLE; OR

(4) FAIL TO COMPLY WITH ANY CONDITIONS FOR VARIANCES ON EXEMPTIONS AUTHORIZED UNDER § 9-409 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) ANY PERSON.

A PERSON MAY NOT FAIL TO COMPLY WITH ANY ORDER ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY UNDER § 9-405 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

9-413. PENALTIES.(A) CIVIL PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO WILLEFULLY VIOLATES § 9-412(A)(3) OR (4) OF THIS SUBTITLE IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY OF UP TO \$5,000 FOR EACH DAY ON WHICH THE VIOLATION EXISTS.

(B) CRIMINAL PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES § 9-412(A)(1) OR (2) OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS
