

ON A SINGLE LOT AND HAVING A CAPACITY IN EXCESS OF 5,000 GALLONS PER DAY.

(L) POTABLE WATER.

"POTABLE WATER" MEANS WATER FREE FROM IMPURITIES IN AMOUNTS SUFFICIENT TO CAUSE DISEASE OR HARMFUL PHYSIOLOGICAL EFFECTS, WITH THE BACTERIOLOGICAL AND CHEMICAL QUALITY CONFORMING TO APPLICABLE STANDARDS OF THE DEPARTMENT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection formerly appeared as Article 43, § 387C(a)11.

(M) SEWAGE.

"SEWAGE" MEANS HUMAN EXCRETIONS, ANIMAL EXCRETIONS, STREET WASH, AND ANY DOMESTIC AND MANUFACTURING WASTE.

(N) SEWERAGE SYSTEM.

(1) "SEWERAGE SYSTEM" MEANS THE CHANNELS BY WHICH SEWAGE IS COLLECTED AND DISPOSED OF, TOGETHER WITH THE BODY OF WATER INTO WHICH IT IS DIRECTLY DISCHARGED, AND ALL STRUCTURES AND APPURTENANCES, MADE USE OF IN ITS COLLECTION AND PREPARATION FOR DISCHARGE IN SATISFACTORY CONDITION INTO THE WATERS OF THIS STATE.

(2) "SEWERAGE SYSTEM" INCLUDES ANY SEWER, NO MATTER WHAT ITS LENGTH AND SIZE MAY BE.

(3) "SEWERAGE SYSTEM" DOES NOT INCLUDE THE PLUMBING SYSTEM INSIDE ANY INDIVIDUAL BUILDING SERVED BY THE SEWERAGE SYSTEM.

(O) SOLID WASTE ACCEPTANCE FACILITY.

"SOLID WASTE ACCEPTANCE FACILITY" MEANS ANY SANITARY
