

"INDEPENDENT SYSTEM" MEANS A WATER SYSTEM, SEWERAGE SYSTEM, OR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SYSTEM THAT:

(1) IS NOT OPERATED BY A SANITARY COMMISSION OR A MUNICIPALITY; AND

(2) SERVES TERRITORY NOT SERVED BY A PROJECT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added for clarity. It is based on the first sentence, except for the last clause of that sentence, of former Article 43, § 666.

(H) MEMBER COUNTY.

"MEMBER COUNTY" MEANS A COUNTY THAT:

(1) HAS FORMED OR JOINED A DISTRICT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND

(2) HAS NOT WITHDRAWN FROM THE DISTRICT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added for clarity.

(I) MUNICIPAL SYSTEM.

"MUNICIPAL SYSTEM" MEANS A WATER SYSTEM, SEWERAGE SYSTEM, OR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SYSTEM THAT:

(I) IS OPERATED BY A MUNICIPALITY; AND

(II) SERVES TERRITORY NOT SERVED BY A PROJECT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added for clarity.

(J) PROJECT.

"PROJECT" MEANS A WATER SYSTEM, SEWERAGE SYSTEM, SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SYSTEM, OR SOLID WASTE ACCEPTANCE FACILITY OR ANY PART OF THESE THAT A DISTRICT OWNS, CONSTRUCTS, OR OPERATES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Article 43, § 645(1).

The references to "solid waste disposal system" and "solid waste acceptance facility" are added for clarity, to avoid repetition of phrases such as "project, solid waste disposal system, or solid waste acceptance facility" and to clarify that this subtitle authorizes districts to
