

EACH SANITARY COMMISSION SHALL APPOINT A SECRETARY-TREASURER.

(C) OTHER OFFICES.

IN A SINGLE COUNTY DISTRICT, A SANITARY COMMISSIONER MAY NOT HOLD ANY OTHER OFFICE OF THE COUNTY.

9-625. QUORUM; COMPENSATION.

(A) QUORUM.

UNLESS THE BYLAWS OF THE DISTRICT REQUIRE A LARGER NUMBER, A MAJORITY OF THE FULL AUTHORIZED MEMBERSHIP OF THE SANITARY COMMISSION IS A QUORUM.

(B) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.

EACH SANITARY COMMISSIONER IS ENTITLED TO:

(1) COMPENSATION AS APPROVED AND PAID BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE MEMBER COUNTY FROM WHICH APPOINTED; AND

(2) REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES AS PROVIDED IN THE DISTRICT'S BUDGET.

9-626. DUTIES OF SECRETARY-TREASURER.

(A) RECEIPT OF REVENUES.

THE SECRETARY-TREASURER OF THE SANITARY COMMISSION SHALL:

(1) COLLECT ALL CHARGES AND ASSESSMENTS MADE BY THE DISTRICT;
