

THE DISTRICT SHALL REPAY ADVANCES MADE UNDER THIS SECTION.

(C) SOURCE OF REPAYMENT.

IF A BOND ISSUE IS MADE FOR THE SERVICE AREA FOR WHICH ADVANCES WERE MADE UNDER THIS SECTION, THE DISTRICT SHALL REPAY ANY OUTSTANDING ADVANCES TO THE MEMBER COUNTY FROM THE PROCEEDS OF THE FIRST BOND ISSUE.

Subsection (b) of this section is new language added to emphasize that an advance must be repaid.

9-651. CONSOLIDATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS OF SERVICE AREAS.

(A) EFFECT ON BOND OBLIGATION.

IF CONSOLIDATING ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS OF SERVICE AREAS WILL NOT IMPAIR ANY BOND OBLIGATION INCURRED BY A DISTRICT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE DISTRICT MAY CONSOLIDATE THE ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS OF SERVICE AREAS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.

(B) ACTION BY DISTRICT.

IF THE ACTION PROMOTES EFFICIENT OPERATION OF THE SERVICE AREAS, A DISTRICT MAY:

(1) CONSOLIDATE THE OPERATIONAL, ENGINEERING, AND FINANCIAL FUNCTIONS OF SERVICE AREAS;

(2) ALLOCATE COSTS AMONG SERVICE AREAS; AND

(3) IF THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT COMMIT THE FUNDS FOR A SPECIFIC PURPOSE, COMBINE FUNDS OF SERVICE AREAS.

9-652. PROJECT PLANNING FOR SERVICE AREAS; PROPOSED SUBAREAS.
