

THE SANITARY COMMISSION MAY ORDER NECESSARY CHANGES TO THE PLUMBING SYSTEM:

- (I) TO ELIMINATE LEAKS;
- (II) TO PREVENT WATER LOSS; AND
- (III) TO PREVENT UNNECESSARY OR IMPROPER
USE OF SEWERS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the third and fourth sentences, the last clause of the fifth sentence, and the first clause of the seventh sentence of former Article 43, § 660.

The sixth sentence of former Article 43, § 660, which provided for construction of a "private or semipublic water supply or sewerage installation", is deleted as repetitious of similar provisions in former Article 43, § 666, now § 9-664 of this subtitle.

9-664. BUILDING AND OPERATION OF INDEPENDENT SYSTEM.

(A) BUILDING INDEPENDENT SYSTEM -- AUTHORITY.

AN INDEPENDENT SYSTEM MAY BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION:

- (1) BY A MEMBER COUNTY AT ITS OWN EXPENSE; OR
- (2) BY AND AT THE EXPENSE OF THE OWNERS OF PROPERTY THAT WILL BE SERVED BY THE INDEPENDENT SYSTEM.

(B) SAME -- REQUIREMENTS.

A PERSON OR MEMBER COUNTY MAY CONSTRUCT AN INDEPENDENT SYSTEM ONLY IF:

- (1) THE INDEPENDENT SYSTEM WILL SERVE AN AREA THAT IS NOT SERVED BY A PROJECT OR A MUNICIPAL SYSTEM; AND
- (2) THE SANITARY COMMISSION APPROVES.

(C) SAME -- APPLICATION TO SANITARY COMMISSION.

THE PERSON OR MEMBER COUNTY THAT PROPOSES TO CONSTRUCT THE INDEPENDENT SYSTEM SHALL:

- (1) SUBMIT TO THE SANITARY COMMISSION PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE INDEPENDENT SYSTEM; AND
- (2) IF THE SANITARY COMMISSION APPROVES THE
