SUBTITLE 7. REGULATION BY MUNICIPALITIES AND POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.

PART I. DEFINITIONS.

9-701. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY.

"MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY" MEANS:

- (1) THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF A MUNICIPALITY;
- (2) THE TOWN COMMISSIONERS OF A MUNICIPALITY; OR
- (3) ANY OTHER GOVERNING BODY OF A MUNICIPALITY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to avoid repetition in this subtitle of phrases such as "the mayor and council or town commissioners or any other governing body of any city or town" and to standardize references to "authorities" and "municipal authorities".

(C) SYSTEM.

"SYSTEM" MEANS:

- (1) A WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM;
- (2) A SEWERAGE SYSTEM;
- (3) A DRAINAGE SYSTEM; OR
- (4) A REFUSE DISPOSAL SYSTEM.
