- (C) SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR FREDERICK COUNTY.
- (1) AFTER NOTICE FROM THE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY, IF A PROPERTY OWNER IN FREDERICK COUNTY FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY MAY:
 - (I) HAVE ANY NECESSARY CONNECTIONS MADE;
- TO BE CLOSED AND ABANDONED; AND
- (III) CHARGE THE PROPERTY OWNER WITH THE COST OF THE CONNECTION OR CLOSING OR BOTH.
 - (2) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COSTS:
- (I) ARE A LIEN AGAINST THE AFFECTED PROPERTY UNTIL PAID; AND
- AS COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL TAXES.
 - REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Article 43, § 415 and the first, second, third, and fourth sentences of § 414.
 - In subsection (a)(2) of this section, the term "use" is substituted for "the delivery of water or the reception of sewage", for conciseness.
 - In subsection (a)(2)(i) of this section, the phrase "as determined" is substituted for "as may be prescribed", for conciseness.

The last sentence of former Article 43, § 414, which related to penalties for violation of this section, is deleted in light of the provisions of § 9-717 of this subtitle.

- 9-709. REMOVAL OF OBSTRUCTION.
 - (A) NOTICE AND ORDER.
- IF ANY STRUCTURE IN, OVER, OR UNDER A PUBLIC STREET, ROAD, OR ALLEY IN ANY COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY OBSTRUCTS ANY WORK ON A SYSTEM, THE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY SHALL:
- (1) GIVE THE PERSON IN CONTROL OF THE STRUCTURE NOTICE OF THE OBSTRUCTION; AND
- (2) ORDER THE PERSON IN CONTROL OF THE STRUCTURE TO TAKE ANY ACTION NECESSARY, WITHIN A TIME SPECIFIED IN THE ORDER, TO ENABLE THE WORK TO CONTINUE.
