

9-1026. PENALTIES.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.

PART IV. SHORT TITLE.9-1027. SHORT TITLE.

THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE CITED AS THE "MARYLAND WATER QUALITY LABORATORY CERTIFICATION ACT".

The word "Maryland" is substituted for "State" to conform to the short titles of other parts of the Code. See, e.g., Titles 2 through 21 of the Health Occupations Article.

SUBTITLE 11. MISCELLANEOUS SANITARY PROVISIONS.9-1101. SEPTIC TANKS IN GARRETT COUNTY.(A) PERMIT REQUIRED.

IN GARRETT COUNTY, BEFORE CONSTRUCTING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY, A BUILDING THAT WILL NEED A SEPTIC TANK DISPOSAL SYSTEM, THE PERSON WHO PROPOSES TO CONSTRUCT THE BUILDING SHALL OBTAIN A SEPTIC TANK PERMIT FROM THE GARRETT COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT.

(B) APPLICATION FOR PERMIT.

AN APPLICANT FOR A SEPTIC TANK PERMIT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GARRETT COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT:

(1) AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE GARRETT COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT REQUIRES; AND

(2) A PLAN FOR THE SEPTIC TANK SYSTEM.

(C) INSPECTION ALLOWED.
