9-1311. PENALTIES.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR OF ANY RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO:

(1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 MONTHS OR BOTH; OR

(2) FOR A SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.

Title 10. NUISANCE CONTROL.

SUBTITLE 1. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES OF SECRETARY.

10-101. GENERAL CARE OF SANITARY INTERESTS.

THE SECRETARY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE GENERAL CARE OF THE SANITARY INTERESTS OF THE PEOPLE OF THIS STATE.

10-102. INVESTIGATION AND CONTROL OF NUISANCES.

THE SECRETARY SHALL INVESTIGATE ALL NUISANCES THAT AFFECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND DEVISE MEANS FOR THE CONTROL OF THESE NUISANCES.
