11-109. IMPORTING, DISTRIBUTING, OR BREEDING WITHOUT PERMIT.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, A PERSON MAY NOT IMPORT, DISTRIBUTE, OR BREED IN THIS STATE ANY EXOTIC BIRD, UNLESS THE PERSON HOLDS A PERMIT ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY.

11-110. PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR ANY RULE, REGULATION, OR ORDER ADOPTED OR ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE OR THE STATE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000.

11-201. POSTING LIFESAVING CHARTS IN RESTAURANTS.

(A) SECRETARY TO IMPLEMENT PROGRAM.

THE SECRETARY SHALL IMPLEMENT A PROGRAM TO POST, IN EACH FACILITY THAT PREPARES FOOD AND PROVIDES SEATING FOR PATRONS, A DIAGRAM OF ILLUSTRATIVE DIRECTIONS ON THE USE OF MANUAL MANEUVERS TO PREVENT ASPHYXIATION DUE TO CHOKING.

(B) SECRETARY TO ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS.

THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
