SUBTITLE 3. LIMITATIONS ON MANUFACTURE OR SALE.

11-301. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR EYEGLASS AND SUNGLASS LENSES AND FRAMES.

(A) DEPARTMENT TO ESTABLISH REQUIREMENTS.

THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT ESTABLISH SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR EYEGLASS AND SUNGLASS LENSES AND FRAMES.

(B) RESTRICTIONS.

A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR DISPENSE ANY EYEGLASSES OR SUNGLASSES THAT DO NOT MEET THE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

(C) PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000.

11-302. MANUFACTURE, SALE, OR RENTAL OF TOYS DEPICTING TORTURE.

(A) IN GENERAL.

A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY MANUFACTURE, SELL, RENT, OR OFFER FOR SALE ANY TOY THAT IS DESIGNED TO DEPICT TORTURE OR TO RESEMBLE ANY INSTRUMENT THAT IS DESIGNED SPECIFICALLY FOR TORTURE.

(B) EXCEPTIONS.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:

(1) ANY TOY GUN; OR
