

ANY PERSON AGGRIEVED BY A FINAL DECISION OF THE SECRETARY IN A CONTESTED CASE, AS DEFINED IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT, MAY:

(1) APPEAL THAT DECISION TO THE BOARD OF REVIEW;
AND

(2) THEN TAKE ANY FURTHER APPEAL ALLOWED BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.

PART VI. PROHIBITED ACTS; PENALTIES.

11-432. PROHIBITIONS.

(A) GENERAL LIMITATIONS ON SALE.

A PERSON MAY NOT SELL:

(1) AS NEW, ANY BEDDING OR UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE UNLESS THE BEDDING OR UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE IS MADE ENTIRELY FROM NEW MATERIAL;

(2) AS NEW, ANY SECONDHAND FILLING MATERIAL;

(3) ANY BEDDING THAT IS MADE FROM SECONDHAND MATERIAL UNLESS THE BEDDING IS DISINFECTED; OR

(4) ANY BEDDING, UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE, OR FILLING MATERIAL THAT IS NOT TAGGED AS REQUIRED UNDER § 11-423 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) SELLING NURSING HOME OR HOSPITAL BEDDING.

A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR TRANSFER ANY BEDDING THAT WAS USED IN A HOSPITAL OR NURSING HOME UNLESS THE BEDDING IS DISINFECTED BY A LICENSED DISINFECTOR USING A DISINFECTION PROCESS APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
