

In subsection (d)(2) of this section, the phrase "until the tag is in the possession of the consumer" is new language added to fill a gap in the former law.

11-435. PENALTIES.

(A) VIOLATION A MISDEMEANOR.

ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR ANY RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$250 FOR EACH OFFENSE.

(B) SEPARATE VIOLATIONS.

ANY PERSON WHO MAKES, RENOVATES, OR SELLS A PIECE OF BEDDING OR UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE IN VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE, OR ANY RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, COMMITS A SEPARATE OFFENSE FOR EACH PIECE MADE, RENOVATED, OR SOLD.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Article 43, § 67G(a).

In subsection (b) of this section, the former references to types of transfers are deleted as unnecessary in light of the definition of "sell" in § 11-401 of this subtitle.

Also in subsection (b) of this section, the former reference to "remade" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the definition of "renovate" in § 11-401 of this subtitle.
