CHAPTER 243

(Senate Bill 28)

AN ACT concerning

Handgun Permits - Informal Review

FOR the purpose of instituting a procedure to provide a means for a handgun permit applicant to obtain an informal review of the decision of the Superintendent of the Maryland State Police regarding issuance of the permit to the applicant.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 36E(g), (h), (i), (j), and (k), respectively, of Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments, of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 36E(h), (i), (j), (k), and (l), respectively.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

36E.
