Education - Military Recruiting

FOR the purpose of providing that public schools and public institutions of higher education shall provide certain access to certain official military recruiting representatives under certain circumstances.

BY adding to

Article - Education Section 7-111 and 11-103 Annotated Code of Maryland (1978 Volume and 1981 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article - Education

7-111.

EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF A COUNTY BOARD THAT PROVIDES ACCESS TO ITS BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS OR ITS STUDENT INFORMATION DIRECTORY TO ANY PERSON OR GROUP WHICH MAKES STUDENTS AWARE OF OCCUPATIONAL OR EDUCATIONAL OPTIONS SHALL PROVIDE ACCESS ON THE SAME BASIS TO OFFICIAL RECRUITING REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MILITARY FORCES OF THIS STATE AND THE UNITED STATES FOR THE PURPOSE OF INFORMING STUDENTS OF EDUCATIONAL AND CAREER OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE IN THE MILITARY.

EACH PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT PROVIDES ACCESS TO ITS CAMPUS OR ITS STUDENT INFORMATION DIRECTORY TO ANY PERSON OR GROUP WHICH MAKES STUDENTS AWARE OF OCCUPATIONAL OR EDUCATIONAL OPTIONS SHALL PROVIDE ACCESS ON THE SAME BASIS TO OFFICIAL RECRUITING REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MILITARY FORCES OF THIS STATE AND THE UNITED STATES FOR THE PURPOSE OF INFORMING STUDENTS OF EDUCATIONAL AND CAREER OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE IN THE MILITARY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
