

(2) -- THE BOARD CONSISTS OF 3 MEMBERS, 1 TO BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, 1 TO BE APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR OF BALTIMORE, AND 1 TO BE ELECTED BY A MAJORITY OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT.

(3) -- EACH MEMBER SERVES FOR A TERM OF 6 YEARS. THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS SERVING ON JULY 17, 1988.

(4) -- VACANCIES SHALL BE FILLED BY EACH OF THE APPOINTING ENTITIES FOR UNEXPIRED TERMS IN THE SAME MANNER AS THE ORIGINAL APPOINTMENTS.

(5) -- MEMBERS SHALL BE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PUBLIC, KNOWN FOR THEIR OBJECTIVE AND INDEPENDENT JUDGMENT, AND MAY NOT BE EMPLOYED BY OR HOLD ANY COMMISSION WITH ANY GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN THE STATE OR ANY EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION.

(6) -- THE BOARD MEMBERS SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN.

(B) -- THE BOARD MAY EMPLOY A STAFF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY BUDGET.

(C) -- THE BOARD MAY -

(1) -- ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR, SUPERVISE, AND RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH RESPECT TO THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS BY THE EMPLOYEES OF THE BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT WHICH DETERMINE THEIR EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE,

(2) -- INVESTIGATE COMPLAINTS OF UNFAIR PRACTICES BY BALTIMORE CITY AND THE EMPLOYEES OF THE BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBHEADING, TAKE ACTIONS WITH RESPECT TO THESE COMPLAINTS,

(3) -- HOLD HEARINGS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT ITS FUNCTIONS AND POWERS,

(4) -- AFTER CONSULTATION WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF BALTIMORE CITY AND THE EMPLOYEES OF THE BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, ESTABLISH LISTS OF QUALIFIED PERSONS BROADLY REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PUBLIC TO SERVE AS MEDIATORS, FACT FINDERS, AND ARBITRATORS, AND

(5) -- OBTAIN AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO BALTIMORE CITY AND THE EMPLOYEES OF THE BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, MEDIATORS, MEMBERS OF FACT FINDING PANELS, ARBITRATORS, AND OTHER CONCERNED PARTIES, STATISTICAL AND OTHER DATA RELATING TO PUBLIC AND PRIVATE EMPLOYMENT.

(D) -- THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBHEADING, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 417, § 244 THROUGH 256 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND.
