6. A LIST OF MAJOR BRIDGE WORK PROJECTS;

7. A SUMMARY OF THE CAPITAL AND OPERATING PROGRAMS OF THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, AS DEFINED BY THE SECRETARY;

8. FOR EACH LISTED MAJOR CAPITAL PROJECT, AN INDICATION THAT THE REVENUE SOURCE ANTICIPATED TO SUPPORT THAT PROJECT IS FROM FEDERAL, SPECIAL, GENERAL, OR OTHER FUNDS;

9. A GLOSSARY OF TERMS; AND

10. CROSS-REFERENCING OF INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE VARIOUS PARTS OF THE STATE REPORT ON TRANSPORTATION.

(II) THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION PLAN SHALL BE EXPRESSED IN TERMS OF PROGRAM OBJECTIVES AND SHALL INCLUDE A SUMMARY OF THE TYPES OF PROJECTS PROPOSED TO ACCOMPLISH THE PROGRAM OBJECTIVES USING AN INTER-MODAL ADMINISTRATION APPROACH WHEN FEASIBLE.

(3) THE SECRETARY SHALL SUBMIT THE STATE REPORT ON TRANSPORTATION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BY THE THIRD WEDNESDAY OF JANUARY OF EACH YEAR.

(E-1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONDUCT AN ANNUAL CONSULTATION TOUR IN THE COUNTIES AND BALTIMORE CITY. THE ANNUAL CONSULTATION TOUR SHALL BE COMPLETED BY NOVEMBER 15 OF EACH YEAR.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
