CHAPTER 292

(Senate Bill 765)

AN ACT concerning

Department of State Planning - State Planning Commission

FOR the purpose of altering the number of members of the State Planning Commission; deleting obsolete language; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to the State Planning Commission of the Department of State Planning.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 88C - State Planning
Section 4(a)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1979 Replacement Volume and 1981 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 88C - State Planning

4.

(a) (1) There [shall be] IS a State Planning Commission within the Department of State Planning, which [shall constitute] IS an advisory board [for] TO the Department of State Planning.

(2) (I) The State Planning Commission [shall consist] CONSISTS of [nine] 13 members, [seven] 11 of whom [shall be] ARE appointed by the Governor[, of whom none shall be persons holding].

(II) THE APPOINTEES OF THE GOVERNOR:

1. MAY NOT HOLD a salaried State office[,]; AND

2. SHALL BE selected, as far as possible, to reflect different broad geographic, economic and social interests in the State.
