- (3) [They shall] MEMBERS serve for four-year terms, beginning as of June 1 in the year in which appointed, and until their successors are appointed[, except that of the members originally appointed four shall be appointed for a two-year term and the remainder for a four-year term. Members appointed by the Secretary of State Planning and in office on July 1, 1971, shall continue in office until the expiration of their terms].
- (4) The Governor shall fill by appointment any vacancy for the unexpired balance of a member's term.
- (5) Two members of the Commission [shall be] ARE ex officio members, one of whom shall be a member of the House of Delegates [of Maryland to be] designated by the Speaker [thereof], and the other of whom shall be a member of the Senate [of Maryland to be] designated by the President [thereof].
- (6) All members [shall] serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties, in accordance with the standard travel regulations.
- (7) The Governor shall appoint a chairman of the Commission.
- (8) (I) The State Planning Commission shall meet as often as necessary but at least twice each year, either on the call of the Secretary or on the call of the chairman.
- (II) The chairman shall call a meeting of the Commission whenever requested to do so by the Secretary of State Planning or by any three members of the Commission.
- (9) The Secretary of State Planning shall designate another member of the staff of the Department of State Planning[, who shall] TO serve as Secretary to the Commission in addition to [his] THAT PERSON'S regular duties of employment with the Department of State Planning.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
