546 21-3. MEMBERSHIP.

- (A) COMPOSITION.
- (1) THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF 9 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE CHARLES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
  - (2) OF THE 9 BOARD MEMBERS:
- (I) 1 SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE BLACK HISTORY GROUP:
- (II) 1 SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE HISTORICAL SOCIETY OF CHARLES COUNTY;
- (III) 1 SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE PISCATAWAY INDIAN TRIBE;
- (IV) 1 SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE SOCIETY FOR THE RESTORATION OF PORT TOBACCO;
- (V) 1 SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE COMMITTEE FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE DR. SAMUEL A. MUDD HOUSE, INC.;
- (VI) 1 SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE CHARLES COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR AN APPOINTED REPRESENTATIVE; AND
- (VII) 3 SHALL BE MEMBERS APPOINTED AT LARGE BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
- (B) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION IS 3 YEARS;
- (2) THE TERM OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ON JULY 1, 1982;
- (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED;
