546 21-3. MEMBERSHIP.

(A) COMPOSITION.

(1) THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF 9 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE CHARLES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

(2) OF THE 9 BOARD MEMBERS:

(I) 1 SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE BLACK HISTORY GROUP;

(II) 1 SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE HISTORICAL SOCIETY OF CHARLES COUNTY;

(III) 1 SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE PISCATAWAY INDIAN TRIBE;

(IV) 1 SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE SOCIETY FOR THE RESTORATION OF PORT TOBACCO;

(V) 1 SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE COMMITTEE FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE DR. SAMUEL A. MUDD HOUSE, INC.;

(VI) 1 SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE CHARLES COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR AN APPOINTED REPRESENTATIVE; AND

(VII) 3 SHALL BE MEMBERS APPOINTED AT LARGE BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

(B) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION IS 3 YEARS;

(2) THE TERM OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ON JULY 1, 1982;

(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED;
