(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED.

547 21-4. OFFICERS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE COMMISSION ANNUALLY SHALL ELECT A PRESIDENT, SECRETARY, AND TREASURER.

(B) ELECTIONS AND TERMS OF OFFICE.

THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND MEETINGS SHALL BE AS THE COMMISSION DETERMINES.

- 548 21-5. MISCELLANEOUS POWERS AND DUTIES.
- (A) THE COMMISSION MAY ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF CURATOR.
- (B) THE COMMISSION MAY ESTABLISH AN OFFICE OF THE CURATOR FOR CHARLES COUNTY LOCATED IN THE SOUTHERN MARYLAND ROOM OF THE CHARLES COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE.
- (C) THE COMMISSION MAY ACCEPT FUNDS, GIFTS, LEGACIES, BEQUESTS, AND ENDOWMENTS FROM PRIVATE SOURCES FOR ANY PURPOSE THAT IS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE COMMISSION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the initial terms of office of the members of the Charles County Heritage Commission shall be:
- (1) 3 members appointed for an initial term of 1 year;
- (2) 3 members appointed for an initial term of 2 vears; and
- (3) 3 members appointed for an initial term of 3 years.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
