- (1) FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE STATE ADVISORY BOARD, THE BOARD CHAIRMAN SHALL APPOINT A BOARD SECRETARY.
- (2) THE BOARD SECRETARY SHALL KEEP FULL AND ACCURATE MINUTES OF EACH BOARD MEETING.

 - (A) MEETINGS.

THE STATE ADVISORY BOARD SHALL MEET REGULARLY AT LEAST 10 TIMES A YEAR, ON THE CALL OF ITS CHAIRMAN.

- (B) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.
- A MEMBER OF THE STATE ADVISORY BOARD:
 - (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
