

of business is located; or (2) instituted by the Board of Licensing Commissioners on its own initiative; or (3) in Prince George's County, instituted by the municipality in which the licensed place of business is located subsequent to a public hearing by the municipality. If the protest has been filed it shall be heard and determined as in the case of original applications, except in Baltimore City it shall be heard and determined not as in the case of original application in regard to zoning but only on a specific complaint as to the operation of the licensee's establishments.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 316

(Senate Bill 1118)

AN ACT concerning

Queen Anne's County - Alcoholic Beverages
