

(3) EACH STATE AGENCY WHICH LEASES ANY STATE-OWNED PROPERTY TO BUSINESS ENTITIES SHALL PROMULGATE REGULATIONS THAT ESTABLISH THE PROCEDURES SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (C)(2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

(House Bill 159)

AN ACT concerning

Determination of Death

~~FOR the purpose of altering the definition of legally or medically dead by incorporating the definition for respiratory and cardiac death with the definition for brain death, and generally redefining the determination of death.~~

FOR the purpose of adopting the Uniform Determination of Death Act; and repealing the provision that pronouncement of death shall be made under certain circumstances; and generally redefining the determination of death; and providing that a pronouncement of death under this Act shall be made before any vital organ is removed for transplantation.
