Article - Health Occupations

10-205.

- (a) In addition to the powers set forth elsewhere in this title, [each member of] the Board [may administer oaths and take affidavits for any matter under the jurisdiction of the Board.] HAS THE FOLLOWING POWERS:
- (1) EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD MAY ADMINISTER OATHS AND TAKE AFFIDAVITS FOR ANY MATTER UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE BOARD; AND
- (2) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE INCLUDING-STANDARDS FOR-PATIENT-GARE.

10-205.1.

- (A) IN CONNECTION WITH ANY INVESTIGATION OF CHARGES UNDER § 10-312 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE BOARD MAY REQUEST THE LICENSEE TO SUBMIT TO AN APPROPRIATE PHYSICAL OR MENTAL EXAMINATION BY A LICENSED PHYSICIAN DESIGNATED BY THE BOARD.
- (B) IN RETURN FOR THE PRIVILEGE GIVEN TO A LICENSEE TO PRACTICE OPTOMETRY IN THIS STATE, THE LICENSEE IS DEEMED TO HAVE:
- (1) CONSENTED TO SUBMIT TO AN EXAMINATION UNDER THIS SECTION, IF REQUESTED BY THE BOARD IN WRITING; AND
- (2) WAIVED ANY CLAIM OR PRIVILEGE AS TO THE TESTIMONY OR EXAMINATION REPORTS OF THE EXAMINING PHYSICIAN.
