- (19) Is professionally, PHYSICALLY or mentally incompetent;

- (21) HAS HAD A LICENSE TO PRACTICE OPTOMETRY DENIED, SUSPENDED OR REVOKED IN ANOTHER STATE FOR AN ACT WHICH WOULD BE GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER THIS SECTION; OR
- (22) FAILS--TO--PERFORM--ANY-PATIENT-EXAMINATION REQUIRED-BY-THE-BOARD; OR
- $\mbox{\em (23)}$ HAS VIOLATED ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE.

CHAPTER 351

(House Bill 424)

AN ACT concerning

Board of Physical Therapy Examiners - Disciplinary Action

FOR the purpose of making a plea of guilty, a plea-ef-guilty er finding of guilty, or making a plea of nolo contendere, to a felony or a crime involving moral turpitude by a physical therapist or a physical therapist assistant, grounds for disciplinary action before the Board and requiring the court to make certain reports to the Board by a certain date and requiring-the-court-te-make--certain-reports-te-the Board-by-a-certain-date.
