Subject to the hearing provisions of § 13-316 of this subtitle, the Board may deny a license, temporary license, or restricted license to any applicant, reprimand any licensee or holder of a temporary license or restricted license, place any licensee or holder of a temporary license or restricted license on probation, or suspend or revoke a license, temporary license, or restricted license if the applicant, licensee, or holder:

- (A) EACH COURT SHALL REPORT TO THE BOARD EACH CONVICTION OF OR ENTRY OF A PLEA OF CUILTY OR NOLO CONTENDERE BY A PHYSICAL THERAPIST OR PHYSICAL THERAPIST ASSISTANT FOR ANY FELONY OR CRIME INVOLVING MORAL TURPITUDE.
