- (1) The office of a physician who is treating patients within the scope of the physician's practice;
 - (2) A hospital that is:
- (i) Licensed under Title $\frac{12}{2}$ $\frac{19}{2}$, subtitle 3 of this Article; and
- (ii) Accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Hospitals;
- (3) Alcoholics anonymous or other similar organizations, if the organization merely holds meetings to help individuals who show the effects of alcohol abuse or alcoholism;
- (4) An employees' assistance program of a business entity; or
 - (5) The American Council on Alcoholism, Inc.
- (c) The Department shall adopt rules and regulations that set standards for certification of alcohol abuse facilities.
- [(d) This section is effective only on and after July 1, 1983.]
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

Air Quality Control - Violation and Enforcement
