SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapter ____ (H.B./S.B. ____) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1982) read(s) as follows:

(c) If, [within 1 year] WITHIN 36 MONTHS after a civil penalty is ~~imposed~~ COMPROMISED AND SETTLED under this section, the person against whom the penalty is imposed satisfies the Secretary that the violation has been eliminated or the order ~~er--plan--for--compliance~~ has been satisfied, the Secretary, with the concurrence of the Attorney General, may return to the person not more than 75 percent of the amount of the penalty paid.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
