- 6-120. USE OF GROUP HOMES AND INSTITUTIONS; REIMBURSEMENT.
 - (A) GROUP HOMES AND INSTITUTIONS.

THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PROVIDE FOR CARE, DIAGNOSIS, TRAINING, EDUCATION, AND REHABILITATION OF CHILDREN BY PLACING THEM IN GROUP HOMES AND INSTITUTIONS THAT ARE OPERATED BY NONPROFIT CHARITABLE CORPORATIONS.

(B) REIMBURSEMENT.

- (1) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL REIMBURSE THESE CORPORATIONS FOR THE COST OF THESE SERVICES AT APPROPRIATE MONTHLY RATES THAT THE ADMINISTRATION DETERMINES, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- (2) THE REIMBURSEMENT RATE MAY DIFFER BETWEEN HOMES AND INSTITUTIONS THAT PROVIDE INTERMEDIATE SERVICES, AS DEFINED BY THE ADMINISTRATION, AND HOMES AND INSTITUTIONS THAT PROVIDE FULL SERVICES.
