Defined term: "Administration" § 6-101 6-122. YOUTH SERVICES BUREAUS.

(A) "YOUTH SERVICES BUREAU" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "YOUTH SERVICES BUREAU" MEANS A COMMUNITY BASED ENTITY THAT IS OPERATED:

- (1) TO PROVIDE COMMUNITY ORIENTED DELINQUENCY PREVENTION AND YOUTH DEVELOPMENT;
- (2) TO AMELIORATE CONDITIONS THAT BREED DELINQUENCY AND FAMILY DISRUPTION; AND
 - (3) TO FUNCTION AS AN ADVOCATE OF YOUTH NEEDS.
 - (B) DUTIES OF ADMINISTRATION -- RULES AND REGULATIONS.
- (1) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT SET ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES FOR STATE FUNDING OF YOUTH SERVICES BUREAUS UNDER THIS SECTION.
- (2) THE RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL REQUIRE THAT EACH STATE AIDED YOUTH SERVICES BUREAU PROVIDE, FREE OF CHARGE, AT CONVENIENT HOURS:
- (I) INDIVIDUAL, FAMILY, AND GROUP COUNSELING;
 - (II) REFERRAL AND INFORMATION SERVICES;
 - (III) CRISIS INTERVENTION;
 - (IV) INFORMAL COUNSELING; AND
- (V) IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARTICULAR COMMUNITY NEEDS:
 - 1. TUTORING;
 - 2. ALTERNATIVE LEISURE ACTIVITIES;
 - 3. EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE;
 - 4. COMMUNITY EDUCATION; AND
 - 5. OTHER SPECIALIZED SERVICES.
 - (C) SAME -- REVIEW OF ELIGIBILITY.

THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:
