SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

4-806.

(D) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, THE DEPARTMENT, AFTER DUE HEARING ON AT LEAST 10 DAYS' NOTICE TO THE LICENSEE, MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IF THE LICENSEE OR HIS AGENTS HAVE BEEN CONVICTED OF VIOLATIONS ON EACH OF ~~2~~ 3 OR MORE DAYS IN ANY LICENSE YEAR OF ANY PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE OR OF DEPARTMENTAL REGULATIONS RELATING TO CRABS.

4-809.

(a) A person may not catch or possess more than [four] 10 hard crabs per bushel or [ten] 25 hard crabs per barrel which measure less than 5 inches across the shell from tip to tip of spike, any peelers measuring less than 3 inches across the shell from tip to tip of spike, or any soft crabs measuring less than three and one-half inches across the shell from tip to tip of spike.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect on July 1, 1982, ~~contingent upon the taking of failure to take effect of Chapter of the Acts of 1982 (H. B. / S. B. No. 677) (21x1630), and if Chapter does not become becomes effective, this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.~~
