- (d) In cooperation with the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, the Department of Education shall adopt standards, rules, and regulations to carry out the provisions of this section.
- (e) A student whose parent or guardian objects in writing to hearing and vision [testing] SCREENING on the ground that it conflicts with the tenets and practice of a recognized church or religious denomination of which he is an adherent or member may not be required to take these [tests] SCREENINGS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
