CHAPTER 382

(House Bill 927)

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County - Board of Education Affidavit of Disclosure PG 407-82

FOR the purpose of repealing a provision of law that allows parents or guardians who are newly arrived residents of Prince George's County a certain time period to complete affidavits of disclosure.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Education Section 7-102 Annotated Code of Maryland (1978 Volume and 1981 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article - Education

7-102.

- (a) The Prince George's County Board shall develop an affidavit of disclosure form to be completed and signed by the parents or guardians of a student who is entering the public schools of Prince George's County.
- (b) By regulation, the County Board shall make completion of an affidavit of disclosure a prerequisite for admission to the public schools[, except that parents and guardians who are newly arrived residents shall be allowed 30 days after enrollment, if necessary, to complete the affidavit].
- (c) The purpose of the affidavit of disclosure is limited to ascertaining from the parents or guardians of a student in the public schools:
 - (1) Their legal residence; and
- (2) The duration of their residency in this State.
