FOR the purpose of prehibiting providing that the Queen Anne's County Treasurer from-receiving is entitled to collect commissions on tax sales; providing that the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County shall set the salary of the County Treasurer; altering the salary of the county treasurer; providing that the salary alteration of the Treasurer's salary shall not take effect until the next following term of office of the Treasurer; clarifying language; requiring the county treasurer to account for and pay into the general county fund any additional compensation or fee paid to him; and generally relating to the compensation of the Queen Anne's County Treasurer.
