from taking an examination.

- (B) (1) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE BOARD MAY WAIVE ANY EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR AN APPLICANT WHO IS LICENSED TO TEACH BEAUTY CULTURE IN ANY STATE, POSSESSION, OR TERRITORY OF THE UNITED STATES, THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, OR PUERTO RICO.
- (2) THE BOARD MAY GRANT A WAIVER UNDER THIS SUBSECTION ONLY IF THE APPLICANT:
- (I) PAYS THE APPLICATION FEE REQUIRED BY § 500 OF THIS SUBTITLE;
- (II) PROVIDES ADEQUATE EVIDENCE THAT THE APPLICANT:
- 1. MEETS THE QUALIFICATIONS OTHERWISE REQUIRED BY THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- 2. BECAME LICENSED IN THE OTHER STATE AFTER PASSING AN EXAMINATION IN THAT STATE THAT IS SIMILAR TO THE EXAMINATION FOR WHICH THE APPLICANT IS SEEKING THE WAIVER.

- (d) Any holder of a license issued for the teaching of beauty culture under the provisions of this subtitle, shall be required to attend -{-at least one course, seminar or program approved by the Board once every two years-}- 0NGE EVERY-2-YEARS-AT-BEAST-16-HOURS-AND-NOT-MORE-THAN--36-HOURS IN--A-SEMINAR--APPROVED--BY-THE-BOARD and [such] THE holder shall be required to submit to the Board a certificate verifying [such] THE attendance before a renewal of a certificate of registration is issued.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
