INDIVIDUAL NEEDS THE INFORMATION FOR HEALTH REASONS. IN THE CASE OF AN AGENCY RECORD, THE ADOPTION AGENCY MUST HAVE REFUSED TO RELEASE THE HEALTH INFORMATION TO THE INDIVIDUAL.

- (B) THE COURT SHALL ORDER OPEN TO INSPECTION BY THE INDIVIDUAL THE PART OF THE RECORD CONTAINING THE NEEDED MEDICAL INFORMATION IF THE COURT FINDS THAT ANY MEDICAL INFORMATION IN THE COURT OR ADOPTION AGENCY RECORD OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S ADOPTION IS NEEDED FOR THE HEALTH OF THE INDIVIDUAL OR OF ANY BLOOD RELATIVE OF THE INDIVIDUAL. IN THE CASE OF AN ADOPTION AGENCY RECORD, THE ADOPTION AGENCY MUST HAVE REFUSED TO RELEASE THE HEALTH INFORMATION.
- (C) THE RECORD WHICH THE ADOPTED INDIVIDUAL INSPECTS MAY NOT CONTAIN ANY INFORMATION WHICH REVEALS THE IDENTITY OR LOCATION OF THE NATURAL PARENTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
