- (i) The right to be treated with consideration, respect, THE--RIGHT--TO--PRIVACY, and full recognition of human dignity and individuality;
- (ii) The right to receive treatment, care, and services that are adequate, appropriate, and in compliance with relevant State and federal laws, rules, and regulations;

(III) THE RIGHT TO PRIVACY;

(iv) (V) The right to be free from physical and chemical restraints, except for restraints that a physician authorizes for a clearly indicated medical need;

CHAPTER 390

(House Bill 1039)

AN ACT concerning

Hazardous-Waste Controlled Hazardous Substance Facility Sites Health and Safety Standards

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene by rule or regulation to set health and safety standards for hazardeus---waste controlled hazardous substance facility sites by taking certain considerations into account; and deleting certain duplicative provisions relating to health and safety standards for the siting of a low-level nuclear facility.
