- (2) Confer upon the person the legal status of an invitee or licensee to whom a duty of care is owed; or
- (3) Assume responsibility for or incur liability as a result of any injury to the person or property caused by an act of omission of the person.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 392

(House Bill 1060)

AN ACT concerning

St. Mary's County <u>and Charles County</u> - State's Attorney's Salary

FOR the purpose of providing that the State's Attorney's salary in St. Mary's County and Charles County shall be a certain percent of the salary of a judge of the District Court of Maryland; providing when salary increases may take effect; and providing this Act does not affect the incumbent incumbents.
