

6-129. STAFF GENERALLY.

IN COOPERATION WITH THE SECRETARY OF PERSONNEL, THE DIRECTOR SHALL:

(1) SET MINIMUM SALARIES, QUALIFICATIONS, AND STANDARDS OF TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE FOR THE POSITIONS IN THE ADMINISTRATION; AND

(2) FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES WHO DESIRE TRAINING AND WHOSE SERVICE RECORDS SHOW MERIT FOR TRAINING, PROVIDE:

(I) IN SERVICE TRAINING;

(II) EDUCATIONAL SUBSIDIES, SCHOLARSHIPS, AND STIPENDS; AND

(III) INSTITUTES, CONFERENCES, AND CLASSES.

6-130. INFORMATION PROGRAMS.

THE DIRECTOR SHALL PLAN AND HOLD INSTITUTES, CONFERENCES, AND OTHER PROGRAMS TO INFORM AND ACQUAINT THE JUDICIARY, BALTIMORE CITY COMMISSION AND OTHER BOARDS OF LOCAL DEPARTMENTS OF SOCIAL SERVICES, CITIZENS ACTION GROUPS, AND OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS WITH THE FUNCTIONS AND PROGRAMS OF THE ADMINISTRATION.
